



## James "Jim" A. Malott Jr.

May 22, 1955 - October 27, 2021

James A. "Fatty" Malott Jr., born on May 22nd, 1955 and raised in Columbus, Ohio, suddenly went home to be with the Lord at the age of 66 on October 27th, 2021. A man after God's own heart, a devoted Christian, a husband who fervently cherished his bride, and a father to the fatherless. Jim was a willing participant in the mission to share Christ. As an advocate of the Truth, and a student of the Word, Jim opened his heart and his home as he taught, served, mentored, and led many to Christ. Jim helped to spearhead the spiritual transformation of Columbus' West Side by impacting countless lives throughout his 20-year tenure with Central Ohio Youth for Christ (COYFC). After graduating from West High School in Columbus, Ohio, he served his community as a mechanic for many years prior to following his calling with COYFC. He served as a home church leader in Dwell Community Church for 23 years. Among Jim's many passions were the Lord, the Word, his beautiful bride Kathy, as well as Oldsmobiles and other vintage cars, young people, and the study of the End Times. Survived by his loving wife Kathy E. Malott; two half-brothers, Larry Meadows and Sonny Meadows; his half-sister, Barbara Johnston; and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends. Jim was preceded in death by his parents, Rolene and James A. Malott, Sr.; and brother, Tim Malott.
