Dr. Janice Gallagher age 58, of Columbus, OH passed away September 10 at Riverside Methodist Hospital surrounded by her family. Janice was born December 4, 1953, in Columbus, to Helen (nee Gale) and the late Dudley “Ned” Gallagher. Preceded in death by her father, Dudley “Ned” Gallagher.
