Jessica L Wilt, age 38, passed away peacefully on November 12, 2015 at The James Cancer Hospital surrounded by family after a courageous 18-month battle against Ewing's Sarcoma. Jessica lived in New York City for the past 8 years prior to returning to Dublin, Ohio to stay with her parents during her cancer treatment. She is a 1995 graduate of Dublin High School, received her BFA in dance from the University of South Florida, MFA in choreography from The Ohio State University and founded ArtsEdTechNYC. Jessica touched many lives through the Team Jessica Wilt Facebook page; always positive and inspiring. A tap dancer at heart, Jessica fought tirelessly as an Arts Education Advocate, which was her passion. We will miss her beautiful smile and determination. She is survived by parents, Jeff and Julie, brothers, Jared (Audrey) and Justin (Laura) and sister, Jenna (fiancé David Sacolick), niece and nephew Olivia and Jacob Wilt, ex husband, Charles Landerfield and aunts, uncles, cousins and many, many friends. The family would especially like to thank her doctors David Liebner and Douglas Martin, and The James nursing staff, in particular 17 James. She received the most wonderful and compassionate care during her cancer journey.
