WANG Dr. Jianjun "Jim" Wang, age 53, passed away on Sunday, December 14, 2008 at Mount Carmel Hospital after long fight with cancer. Jim was born in Ningbo, China on October 10, 1955, graduated from Zhejiang University in 1982, and received his Ph.D. from Rutgers University in 1992. Dr. Wang was an esteemed Senior Fellow at Abbot Laboratory with many innovative discoveries and held dozens of patents. An outstanding leader of the Chinese community, he helped found and chaired several local and national organizations, such as Midwest Chinese Association, Ohio Contemporary Chinese School, Chinese School Association in the US, and China Culture Link. He is survived by his mother, Laifen Ye; wife, Aiping Shao; daughter and son-in-law, Josephine and Jerry Hsieh; daughter, Sherry Wang; and three sisters in China, Yaping, Yamin and Yazhen Wang.
