John is also survived by his wife Aloha; daughters Emily of Dublin (grandson Jacob) and Karen of Dublin (granddaughter Kamryn); stepchildren: Evan, Caleb and Audra; brothers: Jeff (Jeannette), of Flint, Michigan and Randy (Judy), of Morresville, Indiana; nieces Sarah and Beth; nephews Eric and Charlie. He has many close extended family members including the Loeprichs many of which annually gather at Moose Horn Lodge, Canada. John graduated from Worthington High School, Class of 1976. He served in the United States Air Force from 1979-1992. During his service he received many service and leadership medals and ribbons. He served his country in Operation Desert Shield/Storm and was also stationed in Germany, Alaska, Florida and Utah. He was named "Beast" in their football games. John was an employee of Armstrong World Industries for over 20 years where he received several awards as an employee and as a manager. As an Environmental, Health & Safety Manager, he holds the record for the longest period of OSHA non-recordable injuries for the entire corporation. John was a master fisherman - winning contests and has fishing all over the United States and overseas. He was a member of Lifepoint Church in Hilliard, Ohio and other community organizations. He was blessed with the incredible support and friendship

which he received from these groups. He has also resided in Worthington and Hilliard. John was a 6'3" vivacious man who was full of life every day. He was a fierce outdoorsman. He was bold in his conversation and passionate about his interaction with people. He impacted many lives during his time with us. He is an unforgettable person who will live in our hearts and memories forever. He looks forward to seeing us in Heaven.
