John David Dunbar, M.D. passed away on Friday, October 15, 2010, after an extended illness. David was born on February 28, 1929, in Waterford, Ohio. The doctor who treated him during a childhood illness inspired him to become a physician, and he graduated from Ohio State with that goal in 1951. He attended medical school at Ohio State, graduating in 1955, and after an internship in San Francisco where he met his future wife, Irene nee Crofts, he served in the U.S. Army Medical Corps followed by a residency at The Ohio State University Medical Hospitals in Columbus. David was a professor of Radiology and Pediatrics at Ohio State and worked at many hospitals in Central Ohio during his tenure with the firm Radiology Incorporated. From 1976 to 1986, he was the head of the radiology department at Park Medical Center, now Ohio State University Hospital East. An avid sports fan, David was particularly enthusiastic about Ohio State football and basketball teams and was an eternal optimist concerning the Buckeye's fortunes. He was also a lifelong golfer and had a hole-in-one to his credit. He also enjoyed tennis, sailing, skiing, fishing and scuba diving. He will be remembered for his keen intellect, his humor, boldness, curiosity and optimism. David is preceded in death by his parents, John W.E. and Esther, nee Fry, and his daughter, Nicki. He is survived by former wives, Irene, Sandra nee Miller; sons, Mark (Linda) and Mike; grandson, Evan; sister Dorothy (Utz); nephews, Dick, David and John and niece, Nancy Utz.
