John C. Falk Sr., 79, of Westerville, Ohio, passed away peacefully on October 10, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Columbus at White Cross Hospital, John graduated from Whetstone High School in 1964 and went on to earn his degree in Business from The Ohio State University. He later received his MBA from Xavier University in 1975. During his time at Ohio State, John was an active and proud member of Pacesetters, Beta Alpha Psi, Beta Gamma Sigma, and Phi Eta Sigma.

John dedicated 44 years of his professional life to Capital Fire Protection Co., where his knowledge, reliability, and kindness left a lasting impact on everyone he worked with. He also served faithfully as Treasurer of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers (SFPE) for 33 years and was a valued member of the Pathways Credit Union Board.

A proud Buckeye and supporter of women's athletics through and through, John was a longtime supporter of Ohio State Women's Basketball and an active member of the Rebounders Club. This included several years as an assistant coach for the Columbus State Community College women's softball team. He was also involved in many organizations over the years, including DeMolay and the Agonis Club.

Outside of his professional and volunteer work, John was known for his love of sports and family. He was an avid slow-pitch softball player, enjoyed bowling, and was a lifelong Ohio State football season ticket holder. Above all, he took the greatest joy in supporting his children and grandchildren in all their

activities — always cheering from the sidelines with pride and love.

John was preceded in death by his parents, Earl and Billie Falk, and his sister, Karen Maienza. He is survived by his devoted wife of 56 years, Joyce (Leuzinger), daughter Jennifer Haugh; son John Jr. (Jennifer); grandsons Aaron Haugh, Dakota Falk, Andrew Haugh, Aiden Haugh, and Caleb Falk; as well as siblings Alan Falk, Sally Falk, and Bill (Janet) Falk.

John will be remembered for his sharp wit, steady presence, and the deep love he had for his family and friends. His legacy lives on through all those who were fortunate enough to know him.
