John Allen Risch, affectionately known as Johnny, passed away in Columbus Ohio on Tuesday, January 9, 2024 at the age of 54. Johnny was a Mother's Day baby, born on May 11, 1969 in Columbus, Ohio to John Dudley and Eva Mae Risch. Johnny spent most of his life in and around Central Ohio.

Johnny was a graduate from Gahanna Lincoln High School in 1987. He went on to further his education studying transportation at THE Ohio State University, class of 1992.
