Julie Ann (Itin) Hawlik, age 70, formerly of West Bloomfield, MI, died Wednesday, March 9, 2011 at the Odyssey House hospice facility, in Columbus, Ohio after a long battle with amyloidosis. Julie was born in 1940 to the late Robert and Carrie Itin. Julie graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Education from the University of Cincinnati in 1962 and a Master's degree in Education from Michigan State University in 1985. In 1963, Julie married Sidney Hawlik. She taught elementary school for 30 years in Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana and Michigan. She was also active in the Kappa Alpha Theta sorority as a collegiate member at the University of Cincinnati and as an alumna member for the last 49 years. In addition to her parents, Julie was preceded in death by her husband, Sidney. Julie is survived by her four siblings, Robert of Dearborn, MI, James (Joanne) of Wyomissing, PA, Thomas (Shirley) of Orchard Lake, MI and Sue (James) Braden, of Dublin, Ohio.
