Kenneth W. Nally, Sr. was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on August 29, 1941 to Mary Lou and Hubert Nally. He passed away of natural causes on February 19, 2023. He attended Scecina Memorial High School and Marian College before enlisting in the U.S. Army in 1960. He served as a Military Police Officer for his six years in the service.

Upon returning home he reconnected with his college sweetheart, Betty, whom he married October 19, 1963. Growing up in Indiana he became a lifelong fan of Notre Dame where he attended retreats and football games whenever possible.
