Kenneth A Platt, age 90, passed away September 7, 2019 in Columbus, OH. Born April 7, 1929 in Rochdale, England, Ken had a larger than life personality and never met a stranger. He was a certified Chiropodist in England before immigrating to Toronto, Canada in 1957, and then to the US shortly after with his family. Once they settled in Columbus, Ohio, Ken spent 10 years with the Wendt Bristol Company, followed by 17 successful years with Willamette Industries. Ken also served as a two-time president of the Brookside Golf and Country Club in the 1980's, where he and his wife Brenda greatly enjoyed their years golfing and socializing. In 1994, Ken and Brenda officially became snowbirds, relocating over the winter to Viera, Florida. They loved spending their time in the sun, golfing their days away and visiting their extensive network of friends. Despite spending the majority of their retired years in Florida, Ken remained a die-hard Ohio State Buckeye fan, and could often be found outside in his block O bucket hat.
