Kim L. Fields, 49, of Columbus passed away Saturday, January 13, after a long and courageous 10 year battle with cancer. Kim, the loving wife of John R. Fields, whom she married July 6, 1996, was born June 11, 1968 in Marietta, Ohio, the daughter of Gary F. and Sandra L. (Wagner) Bishman. Kim graduated from Marietta High School, where she played flute in the concert and marching bands. She also graduated from The Ohio State University in 1991, with degrees in Marketing and Spanish. She was employed in international logistics with Liqui-Box Corporation for 12 years, prior to becoming a stay-at-home mom. She was a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, and was an active volunteer at Immaculate Conception School. 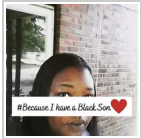
