Kristine A. Jones (Roehl), 42, went to her eternal home on September 15, 2008. With her family at her side, she died at home after a courageous battle with breast cancer. Kris was full of life and her life was full. She was a full-fledged Buckeye who graduated from The Ohio State University with a Masters of Science in Nursing in 1999. She spent her professional career as a certified nurse midwife in practice at OBGYN of Galion and Professionals for Women's Health in Columbus. She was fulfilled through her faith, her family, her career, her music and most significantly through her daughter and best friend Katy. She loved the beach in the summer and the fall in the mountains. She crossed the finish line at the Susan G. Komen for the Cure under her own power for the 7th time as a survivor in May of this year. She was greeted in heaven by her father Rev. W. Keith Roehl. Her surviving family awaits their glorious reunion: her husband of 20 years, James D.; and daughter, Kaitlyn of Powell; mother, Connie Roehl of Grove City; sisters, Cindy (Bryan) Elliott of Grove City, Carie Roehl of Grove City, Cheri (Jim) Davison of Upper Arlington; nephews, Zach and Alex Elliott and niece Reganne Elliott.
