My daughter has told me that the students at the high school are learning just how connected they are to each other. It must be heartbreaking each time you realize that they never will do something or be somewhere as usual. Each time I hug my daughter a little more often than normal I am sharing in this realization. I believe that Lyndsey and Kyle could have done so much more on this earth to promote God's love and acceptance of all who accept Him. However, I also believe that their leaving this earth may actually do more to help teach both youth and adults the importance of living life to the fullest and loving those around them to the fullest like Lyndsey and Kyle did.
