Perry, Ohio to Charles and Maude Wilkins on February 2, 1917. She graduated from Somerset High School in 1935 and went on to become a beautician after attending the Ohio State School of Cosmetology. She married Reynold V. Hazlett on February 25, 1941. Larna and "Ray" moved to Columbus and later to Worthington, Ohio. She became a member of the Worthington Presbyterian Church in 1950 and was a faithful member until her health prohibited attendance. Over the years, Larna volunteered in many areas, always smiling, with a continuing willingness to help others. She was especially gifted in blessing others with her words of encouragement. She was known for her often used phrase of "God Bless you!" Larna loved flowers and was an expert in raising African Violets, at one time caring for over 30 plants and winning numerous awards for them. She was known at Friendship Village as "The African Violet Lady." She loved to give them away and teach others how to grow them. Larna was a very loving mother to surviving son, Gary (Connie Dalton) Hazlett of Nelsonville, Ohio and daughter, Sharon (Richard) Sunkle of Powell, Ohio.
