Larry C Coolidge, Powell, OH, passed away on Wednesday afternoon, November 12, 2025, in OSU Wexner Medical Center. Born in the St Mary's portion of the Mayo Clinic on January 15, 1948. He was the son of Charles Sumner Coolidge and Eleanor Reemsnyder Coolidge, who preceded him, also preceded in death by his brother, Gary.
