Larry L. Goodwin, age 64, of Dublin, lost his hard-fought battle with ALS (Lou Gehrig's disease) Thursday, December 29, 2011, surrounded by his loving wife and family at the Kobacker House Hospice in Columbus, Ohio. Larry was born in Dayton, Ohio on September 27, 1947 to Mary Goodwin, who survives, and the late T.H. "Jim" Goodwin. Survivors include his wife Deborah (Ford) Rurik-Goodwin, of Dublin; daughters Amber (Jay) Schaffer, of Key West, FL and Lindsay (Kelly) Williams, of Lexington, KY; his brother James (Claudia) Goodwin, of Daleville, VA; and three nephews; a niece; a great-nephew; and three great-nieces. A 1965 graduate of Buckeye Local High School and a 1969 graduate of Western Michigan University, he served in the United States Army in Korea. Larry owned and operated the J&J Supermarket in Belle Center, Ohio from 1979-1986, served two years in Bamberg, Germany with the US Army Commissary System and retired after 22 years in the Community Planning and Development Department of HUD.
