Larry Schumick, age 75, of Dublin, OH, passed peacefully on Tuesday, January 13, 2015 at The James Hospital surrounded by his loving family. Larry was a kind, loving and generous man. 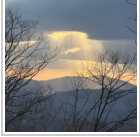
