Linda Zeigler, age 74, passed away on Wednesday, November 30, 2022, while sleeping peacefully at her place of residence in Westerville, Ohio. She was born on January 25, 1948, in Columbus, Ohio, and graduated from Saint Francis DeSales High School in 1966. She attended OSU after graduation, where she majored in English and met the love of her life, William Zeigler, who preceded her in death in December of 1983.
