Majid Saheli, born December 12, 1947, in Langroud, Iran, the eldest of five sons of Mahmoud and Soraya, passed away on Monday June 13th, 2022. He was surrounded by family and friends as they said their last goodbyes at Kobacker House in Columbus, Ohio.

Majid came to the United States in 1971 on a Fulbright Scholarship to attend The Ohio State University where he obtained his degree in Social Work. Majid worked as a Social Work Counselor for the State of Ohio until he retired in 2011.

Majid lived his adult life in Columbus, Ohio and remained a proud Ohio State alumni and fan, always encouraging college bound students to attend his alma mater. Majid was a giving and good son, brother, uncle, and friend.
