



## Margaret McNally

January 14, 1943 - April 29, 2024

Margaret Mary (Maggie) McNally, age 81, New York, NY, died April 29th, 2024 in Columbus, OH. She was born January 14th, 1943, to Joseph C. McNally and Lillian (Walker) McNally in Youngstown, OH. Maggie graduated from Cardinal Mooney High School in 1961. She attended Georgetown University in Washington, DC starting in 1961 (the first-year women were admitted to the university). She graduated in 1965. Maggie worked in Cleveland until 1969. That year she entered the master's degree program in Social Work at Columbia University in New York City. She graduated in 1971. For the next forty plus years she worked at a number of social service agencies in New York. These included Jewish Family Services in Manhattan and Birch Family Services in Riverdale the Bronx, NY. Maggie retired in 2013.

Maggie will always be remembered for her dedication to and caring for the disadvantaged, especially children. She had a unique ability to engage a variety of individuals in conversation, from a frightened child to a complete stranger. Maggie loved a Broadway show, a good Manhattan, and most New York restaurants and museums. Best of all was a dish of Handel's Chocolate Pecan ice cream and a Coca Cola. Maggie will be remembered for her engaging smile, an ability to make anyone comfortable in her presence, and as the most comforting of friends.

Maggie is survived by her brother Patrick McNally and sister-in-law Cynthia Hughes McNally of Columbus, Ohio, and nephew Chip Hughes of Los Angeles, CA.

She is preceded in death by her parents and sister-in-law Mary Anne (Brennan) McNally.

A memorial Mass will be held at St. Christine Church in Youngstown on Tuesday, June 4th, 2024 at 11:00 am.
