March 14, 1913 - March 24, 2018

Margaret Emilie Pauline Knott Voelker, a former longtime resident of Lindenhurst, Long Island, NY passed away peacefully March 24, she was 105 years old. Margaret was born in Astoria, Queens, NY on March 14, 1913 to loving parents, Joseph Knott and Selma Schmidt. She was the youngest of 7 children, Walter, Selma, Eleanor, Joseph, Alfred, and Richard, all of whom predeceased her in death.
