Marian Ruth Davis went to be in the arms of her Lord and Savior On April 11th 2025 at the age of 88. She was raised in Westerville, Ohio and graduated from Westerville High School (1954).

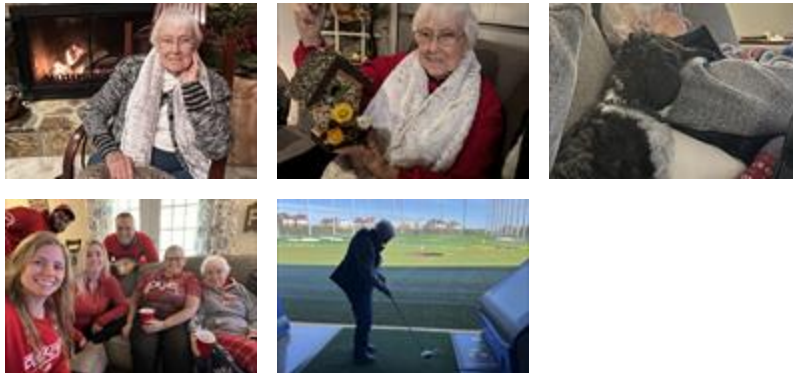
