Marian Benoy Feldmiller, age 84, of Granville, OH formerly of Columbus, passed away Friday, December 16, 2011 at Kendal at Granville Retirement Center. They particularly enjoyed Road Scholar (Elderhostel) programs in the U.S. and abroad, as well as visiting National Parks – anything to get them close to nature. Marian was kind and funny even as Parkinson's disease claimed her health, and she will be missed by all who knew her. Marian is survived by her husband, Vic Feldmiller; daughter, Jennifer (Bob) McLaughlin; son, John Fryman; sister, Joan (Bob) Menson; step-son, David Feldmiller; step-daughter, Vicki (Tom) Nikoncyk; grandchildren, Ryan McLaughlin, Scott, Emily and Grace Feldmiller, and numerous friends.
