Martha L. Daniell, age 100 of Columbus died Thursday, April 1, 2010 at Green Hills Center, West Liberty, Ohio. Martha was born October 13, 1909 in Romulus, Oklahoma. She is preceded in death by her parents, James F. and May White Daniell, sisters and brothers-in-law, Vera (Herb) Payne & Dorothy (Ken) Eby; brothers, Robert Raymond Daniell & Donald K. Daniell.
