



Mary Margaret Haley Leavitt "The Flag Lady"

January 23, 1936 - December 4, 2023

Mary Margaret Haley Leavitt, affectionately known as "The Flag Lady" passed peacefully in her sleep surrounded by her loving family in the early morning of December 4,

2023. Born to Walter Haley and Irene Showers on January 23, 1936. At thirteen she lost her

father to cancer, deeply impacting the woman she became. Asked by her mother to drop out of

school to help with finances, Mary worked three part time jobs while finishing high school as a

North High Polar Bear. She was a most resilient, passionate, hard-working and loyal woman.

It was at North High school that she met the love of her life. She married her high

school sweetheart, Thomas Benson Leavitt in 1956. She often said he was the wind under her

wings. Mary is survived by her three children, Lori Leavitt Watson (Michael), Andrew "Andy"

Benson Leavitt (Brenda) and Charles "Charlie" Haley Leavitt (Janet); grandchildren. Jason

her parents, brother Robert Stevenson, & sisters Rosalyn Archer & Sharon Norman.

Trained as a legal secretary, Mary worked for Arthur I. Vorys of The Vorys Firm for a

number of years before moving to Illinois. Driven by her love of country she began selling the

American flag out of the trunk of her car in 1979. She was dubbed "The Flag Lady" by the

Chicago Sun Times. In 1980 she moved back to Columbus and began her business as "The

Flag Lady. Mary was actively involved in the Clintonville community, loved The Ohio State

Buckeyes, ran for Columbus City Council and was a founding member of the National

Independent Flag Dealers Association (NIFDA), was a long time member of the National

Federation of Independent Businesses (NFIB), as well as a Daughter of the American

Revolution (DAR). She led the pledge of allegiance for two presidential candidates at their

nominating conventions. She was also a member of Grace Polaris church.

Mary loved God, her

family, her country and friends with all that she was. There will be calling hours
