Alice Maureen (Fitzpatrick) Amorose, age 70, of Worthington, Ohio passed away on September 13, 2016 at Kobacker House after a courageous battle with cancer. Over the years she volunteered at Twigs of Children's Hospital, Homeless Families Foundation, American Red Cross, and Evening Street School. She enjoyed reading, quilting, Mahjong and spending time with family and friends. Maureen was preceded in death by her parents; step-mother, Josephine Kennedy Fitzpatrick; sister-in-law, Lynn (Scanton) Fitzpatrick; niece, Erin Fitzpatrick.
