Maxine Andreas, age 89, of Powell, OH passed away Monday, December 15, 2015. Born in Mt. Vernon, OH, Maxine was a graduate of Mt. Vernon High School, Class of 1943. She later graduated from Asbury College, Wilmore, KY, and attained her B.A. degree in 1946. She returned to Mt.
