Mikl A. Davis, age 83 of Columbus, died Tuesday May 10, 2022. She was born on February 8, 1939 in Ironton to the late Glendon and Virginia (Fritz) Davis. Mikl attended school in Cincinnati, attended The Ohio State University for two years and graduated from the University of Cincinnati.
