He grew to become one of the most prominent tax attorneys in the state and had the honor of arguing cases before the Ohio Supreme Court. He was a private pilot, dedicated Ohio State sports fan, a world history buff, enjoyed fishing, snow skiing, traveling the world and being with family and friends.
