Myron Ferry, age 89, passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 23, 2013 at Kobacker House after a five month struggle to recover from surgery due to a fall. He was born in 1924 in Salamanca, New York, spent his formative years in Marion, Ohio and most of his adult life in Dublin, Ohio. He is preceded in death by his wife of 58 years Marilyn Ruth Ferry, his parents Myron E. Ferry, Sr. and Lorene Pensinger, step-father Elmer Pensinger, brother Charles Pensinger, and brother-in-law James Kratzer. Myron was a World War II Veteran, serving as a naval officer in the United States Navy and eventually captaining a ship.
