“ *I was the Volunteer Coordinator at Inniswood Metro Gardens when John and Nancy attended their training classes. Both immediately dove into helping maintain the gardens. They were regulars at Thursday morning work sessions for some time until their dog interfered. It appears he couldn't be left alone for the three hour session without causing some problems. They transitioned into helping with our children's programming since that was only a 1-1/2 hour time commitment. They became faithful regular assistants to our educator, Mr. Barry. But they would always stop and visit with me, mostly talking about their crazy dog - a Jack Russell, I think, and how he wore them out chasing balls for hours. I did meet the dog (who's name I forget) a few times as they would sometimes leave it in the car if they were at the gardens only briefly. I can attest that he put the Energizer Bunny to shame! But Nancy would also talk proudly about her daughters and their accomplishments. I do recall on many visits that they were either going to or coming from caring for one relative or another. She was a very fun and giving person and the world is a better and more beautiful place because of her.*
