Nancy Poss, age 84, of Powell, Ohio, passed away on November 25, 2025. Born in Buffalo, New York, Nancy was the daughter of Henry and Elizabeth Eberle and one of ten siblings. She graduated from Mount St. Joseph Academy in 1958 and The Sisters of Charity Hospital School of Nursing, Buffalo in 1961. Nancy dedicated over two decades to nursing, concluding her healthcare career as a registered nurse at Riverside Methodist Hospital, Columbus, Ohio in the early 1980s.

In 1979, Nancy and her family moved to Worthington, Ohio where they would become longtime residents. Soon thereafter, Nancy would make the pivotal decision to obtain her real estate license. Her commitment and professionalism quickly distinguished her within the real estate industry and Nancy's unwavering passion for her new career and her clients was unmatched. These attributes along with her incredible drive and strength as a tireless worker led to an outstanding real estate career marked by integrity and respect. In the early 1990s, she consistently ranked as the top RE/MAX agent in Central Ohio, and in 1996 achieved national recognition as the #40 RE/MAX agent in the United States and was honored with the RE/MAX Lifetime Achievement Award. In 2002, Nancy and her growing team, which included her son Keith, joined Keller Williams Capital Partners Realty where they would go on to become one of Ohio's leading Keller Williams Realty teams throughout the 2000s. In 2003, Nancy also played a key role as a

foundational owner of Keller Williams Consultants Realty where her vision helped launch this successful venture.

Beyond her career, Nancy enjoyed traveling, cheering on the Ohio State Buckeyes and Buffalo Bills, and participating in church activities. A devout Catholic, she was deeply committed to her faith, cherished friendships, and prioritized her roles as a mother to her five children and grandmother to her beloved nine grandchildren.

Nancy is survived by her daughter Kathy, son Mike (Beth), son Doug (Margot), son Keith (Amber), and her grandchildren: Drew, Mena, Nathan, Megan, Nick, Kylie, Rachel, Caden, and Keira. She is also survived by her siblings: Patricia, Marjorie, Madonna, and Edward. Nancy was preceded in death by her parents, husband Ken, daughter Margaret Mary, and siblings: Fran, Sr. Jeanne, Rosemary, Dick, and Robert.
