Nancy was born in Detroit on February 12, 1934 and died April 2, 2018. She graduated from Birmingham, Michigan high school where she was admitted to the National Honor Society. High school friends said that if Title Nine had existed at that time, more would know that she excelled at sports. Nancy graduated from Michigan State University in 1956. She married Duane Scott in 1955. He loved her the rest of her life and still does. Duane and Nancy had a son named Mark Eldred and a daughter named Karen Lee. Mark has been instrumental in Nancy's end of life care. Interests involved birding, camping, canoeing, and hiking in national and Columbus metro parks. She was a volunteer at Inniswood Parks. She motorcycled in all twelve Canadian provinces, and all U.S. states, except Alaska and Hawaii. She belonged to Buckeye Beemers motorcycle clubs. A lot of the riding had to do with adding to her lifetime bird list. Nancy was a deacon and member of Liberty Church in Powell, where her memorial service will take place in the chapel.
