Nancy Ann (Harper) Witchey, age 88, passed peacefully on August 19, 2019 at The Kobacker House, Columbus, Ohio. Nancy was born on February 15, 1931 in Malaga, OH to Herman and Marie Harper. She graduated from Beallsville High School in 1948 and Wilmington College 1960. Nancy was an elementary school teacher in the Columbus Public School system until she retired in 1987. After retiring, Nancy enjoyed working in the bakery at The Anderson's. Nancy will be remembered for her sense of humor, playing a wicked game of euchre, and mostly as a devoted and loving mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and Aunt.
