A loving wife, mother and grandmother, Pamela Jo (Foos) Shearer spent her final hours surrounded by those she loved and always cared for throughout her life. Foos in Fremont, Ohio, and lived in Ohio and West Virginia throughout her childhood. In 1968, she married William Conway Shearer in Columbus and together they raised two sons while living in Columbus and Illinois. To be closer to family, Pam and Bill retired to Westerville in 2007. They enjoyed traveling and visited Hawaii several times, including a memorable 2007 trip with their children and grandchildren. Pam always took care of her extended family's needs no matter the time or place. She and Bill especially loved hosting their grandchildren for sleepovers and attending their events. She was preceded in death by her mother in 1989. They shared a strong bond and friendship, especially during Mary's own courageous battle with cancer.
