



## Pamela Sue Riedinger

October 28, 1947 - February 9, 2018

Pamela Sue (Pam) Riedinger, age 70,  
Passed away on February 9, 2018 after a lengthy battle with an autoimmune disease.

She was born on October 28, 1947 in Akron Ohio, where hospital staff were all dressed in Halloween costume. That must be why she loved Halloween so much. She always looked forward to the holidays and worked hard to make each one special. . She inherited her love for arts and crafts from her mom, and she enjoyed making things for family and friends. She kept a home-made wreath for every season on her front door. Pam loved to sing in the choir, and passed her love for singing on to her son, Phil. She was a voracious reader and loved to watch movies and travel. Her smile could light up any room, and her eyes could hide no secrets. She was an avid collector of Charming Tails figurines, and she was knowledgeable about every piece that was ever produced. Pam was founder and president of "A Mixed Bag of Nuts" which was an on-line social club for Charming Tails figurines collectors. She travelled to many trade shows and signing events where she developed lasting friendships across the country including the artist, Dean Griff.

When Pam married her husband of 44 years on June 8, 1973, they made their home in Columbus, Ohio. They purchased a small trailer and lived in a park for married students only near the Ohio State University campus. Dave went

to school and Pam got her first job in Columbus working at the University. Their first son, Stephen, was born while living there in 1976. While Steve was still a baby, they moved to their first house in University View in Clinton Township. They were living there when their second son, Philip, was born just before the blizzard of 1978. In 1984, Pam's mother and brother moved in with them, and in 1985 the expanded family relocated to a larger home in Dublin, Ohio. Her biggest love of all was her family and her faith in God.

Pam was a graduate of Hammel Actual Business College in Akron, Ohio, and she attended OSU. She held various secretarial positions at the Ohio State University: Department of Education, the College of Nursing, OSU Medical Center – Dodd Hall, and at Battelle Memorial Institute. She retired in September, 2003 from the US Department of Energy where she was the office manager.

Pam was preceded in death by her parents, Aaron and Juanita (Wilson) Feagain; brother, David Feagain, and nephew, Adam Feagain.

Pam is survived by husband, David; sons Stephen (Katie) and Philip (Max) Riedinger, and three granddaughters (Faith, Hope and Trinity). Also survived by brothers: Robert (Carolyn); Gerald; Jamie (Kristen); and Tim Feagain; sister, Joyce Kennedy; and sister-in-law, Sharon Proctor. Pam will be missed by numerous cousins, nieces and nephews, Riedinger-in-laws; and friends across the states.
