PATRICIA ANNE BADGERO was born on October 17, 1946, in Mt. Clemens, Michigan, the only child of James and Ara (Moore) Badgero. Pat has no children. She died on December 8, 2025, aged 79 years. Pat graduated from Worthington High School (1964) and Ohio University (1968). She started her career with Franklin County as a social worker. Later she worked for, and retired from, the State of Ohio Job and Family Services.

Pat began riding horses at a young age and raised several horses, her prized horse was named Silkman. Pat's skills were on display as she competed in breakaway roping and earned a buckle from OFQHA in steer dobbling (2010). She also enjoyed downhill skiing.

Pat bought an Airstream trailer and joined the Airstream Owners club. She served as president of the Columbus unit. She went on many caravans with the club and saw many parts of the country. Pat met her husband, John Sherron, during a caravan in Texas in 2014 and enjoyed telling the story of how they met.

Pat enjoyed arts and crafts and was a member of the Ohio Gourd Society. For years Pat created unique pieces of art from gourds and her work was featured as a display in the Grove City Library.

Pat is survived by her husband, John Sherron (m. 2018) and a first cousin, John Moore, of Richmond, Virginia. Pat's love for animals has guided her request for donations in lieu of flowers to The Cat Welfare Association in Columbus. Pat was a proud graduate of Ohio University and a scholarship has been created in her honor to support students studying social work. Contributions to the scholarship fund can be made through the Ohio University Foundation.

Visitation will be at Jackson Chapel United Methodist Church, 4473 Jackson Pike, Grove City, on December 17 at 10am followed at noon by a funeral service with Pastor Anita Richter officiating. Burial will be in Byron Cemetery, in Byron, Michigan, at a later date.
