Patricia Jane (Smith) Gano, 90, of Upper Arlington, Ohio, went to be with the Lord on October 18, 2024. The daughter of Andrew Jackson “Sam” Smith and Elizabeth (Turk) Smith, Pat was born on March 26, 1934, in Greenville, South Carolina. She married Peter William Gano in December of 1962 and they were married for 60 wonderful years, living in Santa Barbara, CA; Greenville, SC; Upper Arlington, Ohio; Winona Lake, IN; and North Manchester, IN, carrying cherished lifelong friendships with them from each place they called home.

A graduate of Furman University, Pat was a music, preschool, and early education teacher who loved sharing God's word and its encouragement to many. An avid writer and mentor, her life was full of many unique experiences—ministering around the country, in women's prisons, at prayer conferences and by putting God's message of salvation into a book, which was published the year she turned 80. Her devotion to God was expressed in her passion for sharing the gospel, praying for and over others, seeing people come to a saving knowledge of Jesus as Savior, and discipling them to grow into an abundant faith.
