Paul B. Brody, born August 1, 1925; died January 19, 2016. Paul was married to Carol Yagello Brody for 65 years. He is survived by Carol; children, Jill (Douglas Bryant), John (Kate), Jim (Kim Katz Brody), and Jane (Chris Jay); grandchildren, Maggie Brody Moskal (Brandon), Sam Brody, David Bryant, Matthew Bryant, Lindsie Katz and Jeremy Katz; great-granddaughter, Lucy Moskal; and cousins, Yvonne Lewandowski and Lawrence Kruszewski. A 1943 graduate of South High School, Cleveland, OH, Paul attended Denison University. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1943-1946. He was Sales Manager for A.P. Green Refractories for 35 years and was a long-time member of the American Foundrymen's Society. He served as Chairman of its Central Ohio Chapter from 1970-72. He was a member of the American Ceramic Society where he held numerous positions throughout the years. After retirement, Paul spent many happy hours 'schmoozing' with all his friends at The McConnell Center, Kroger in Clintonville, favorite Columbus restaurants, Champ Henson's at the Clintonville Market and visits to past customers. He was a fan of The Ohio State Buckeyes, the Cleveland Indians and UA Golden Bear Baseball. Paul was a proud and devoted husband, father and grandfather.
