It is with great sadness to announce the passing of Philip C. Weber age 75 at his home in Hilliard, Ohio surrounded by his loving wife, family and friends. Phil was born to the late Robert and Mary (Gilbert) Weber in Columbus, Ohio on July 18, 1950.

After graduating from Whetstone High School in 1968 he attended Franklin University studying business and finance. Phil joined the Ohio National Guard where he later joined the Columbus Police Department on November 14, 1974 until his retirement on January 20, 2001. After retirement Phil and Kathi travelled the United States by RV settling in Fort Meyers Florida where Phil worked for Lee Transit driving a trolley on the beach for many years.

Phil is preceded in death by his parents and brother Steve Weber.

He is survived by his wife Kathleen (Kathi) of 43 years, twin brother Gregory (Dona) Weber, sister-in-law Marion Weber, niece Stephanie (Chris) Logan and their children Trevor, Cameron, Hope and Faith.
