Phil enjoyed his summers with his maternal Aunt Hattie and her family in Geneva, OH., where he spent many summer days at the Geneva local airport hitching rides on small planes. It was there that Phil became fascinated with airplanes. Phil attended East End Lutheran School in Pittsburgh and graduated in 1956 from Oliver High School in Pittsburgh. He served in the 1st Armored Division at Fort Hood, TX (1961-63). He was a Past Master of Corinthian Masonic Lodge ('83) in Pittsburgh. A member of the Sheet Metal Workers Union Local #12 and he retired in 1997 to relocate to Columbus, OH to be with the families of his son and daughter and especially to be with his beloved grandchildren. Phil enjoyed spending time with his children, grandchildren and friends, playing games, talking about current events, sports, politics, reading and traveling. Phil especially enjoyed the many winters we spent as snowbirds at Silver Lakes RV & Golf Resort in Naples, FL, where we made many wonderful, supportive friends over the years. Phil was a smart, kind, quiet, hardworking, honest man who loved his family. His family and friends will miss him.
