Phillip William Karshner, 88, died July 9th, 2022, at Dublin Methodist Hospital. He was known to many over the years when he operated Clintonville Electric Company. He was never employed anywhere else except for his brief tenure (one week) as a Kroger box boy (He was fired). He worked his way through the jobs, sweeping up (at age ten), delivery, service and while in college, sales. When he returned from Army service in 1959, he took over management for his family, and continued until he retired in 2004. Over the years he received many distinguished dealership awards for outstanding sales and customer service. He was a 1952 graduate of Columbus North High School and from The Ohio State University in 1956, graduating in business and finance. He enjoyed attending Old North High Alumni Club with old friends, was a longtime member of Pic-Token Investment Club, Columbus Maennerchor and Linworth United Methodist Church where he was a member for the last 55 years. He and Pat together also participated in and supported many benevolent groups and charities over the years, primarily those involving disabled children.

He was preceded in death by his beloved son, Brian, in 2001 and is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Patricia (nee Garey), Also surviving are son, Matthew W. Karshner M.D., daughter-in-law Lonett Karshner, daughter Christine McSwain, son-in-law Ken McSwain and grandchildren, Laura Elizabeth and Brian William Karshner.
