

Dr. Phillip D. Price

August 7, 1963 - January 11, 2015

Dr. Phillip D. Price, age 51, of Powell, OH, passed away Sunday, January 11, 2015 at home after a brief illness. A native of Medina, OH, he was born to the late Edgar and Jean Price and graduated from Medina High School, Class of 1981. Dr. Price graduated from Capital University in 1985 and was named Outstanding Medical School Candidate upon graduation. He entered The Ohio State University College of Medicine in 1989, and completed his post graduate residency and post graduate internship in General Surgery at Mount Carmel Health. He then joined the Mount Carmel Medical Staff in 1994 and became a member of MidOhio Surgical Associates, Inc. During his career at Mount Carmel Health, was the Chairman of the Network Cancer Committee since 2010; Associate Trauma Director since 1999; Program Director of the Bariatric Surgery Program, 1995-2007; Vice Chair of the Mount Carmel West Department of Surgery from 2001-2002; and Director of Oncological Services since 2008. Dr. Price was instrumental in developing the Mount Carmel Bariatric Program and became the program's first bariatric surgeon and director. He was involved in physician wellness since completing his residency and was among the first in Ohio to have performed many advances laparoscopic procedures, and was known to be the first physician to perform the placement of a gastric stimulator robotically. Dr. Price was a Faculty Member of Mount Carmel Health Surgical Residency Program since 1994. In addition, he was an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Surgery at The Ohio State University, 2013-2015; Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery at Wright State,

2013-2015; Clinical Assistant Professor of General Surgery at the Ohio University College of Osteopathic Medicine, 2012-2015. Dr. Price received the Distinguished Educator Award from the OSU College of Medicine in 2010, as well as the Outstanding Physician Educator Award from the Ohio University College of Medicine in 2011. He was named "Teacher of the Year" by the Mount Carmel surgical residency program multiple times. Dr. Price authored and published many peer reviewed articles and was a reviewer for the Journal of Laparoendoscopic Surgery and was a featured presenter on multiple surgical topics locally, nationally and internationally. Over the years Dr. Price dedicated himself to surgical excellence in cancer care. In 2011 he was named Cancer Liaison Physician at Mount Carmel Health System by the American College of Surgeons. Dr. Price was involved with the Boy Scouts of America for decades. First, as an Eagle Scout himself, and later as a merit badge counselor and assistant scoutmaster with his three sons. He was an accomplished bodybuilder and won Mr. Collegiate Ohio and placed in many other competitions. He is survived by his wife and best friend of 10 ½ years, Brandie Price and by his three loving sons: Brock Richard Price, Grant Winfield Price and Blake Carlton Price, all of Powell; and by his many friends and colleagues. He did my surgery back in Sept of '08. He didn't think he would find anything b/c scan prior to surgery didn't show much. Reiterated my symptoms. I also told him that I prayed about it and got signs that I needed the surgery.

He decided to listen to me. Not focus on the evidence. After surgery, he was perplexed. He found a hole in my diaphragm muscle. Apparently, my former surgeon cut it 10 years before during my initial nissen fundoplication surgery. He said most of my stomach had migrated into my chest. He said he had never seen anything like that before. A complicated and unique operation.

Back in 2007 my first scan indicated I needed surgery. Two surgeons at a prominent clinic refused to operate. I was told by my PCP before even going to that clinic that they wouldn't do surgery b/c of my insurance. I was on Medicaid (Molina).

Took that initial scan to Dr. Price. He said I needed surgery. Then the follow up scan indicated my wrap migrated down and surgery became more of an option.

So my first scan indicated I needed surgery but two surgeons refused to operate. Money was their concern. Dr. Price's scan indicated surgery was optional but agreed to operate. Money was not his concern. If he wasn't patient focused, I wouldn't be where I am today. Able to work full time. My stomach would still be migrating into my chest cavity. Many days struggling just to breathe.

I can only hope and pray that the people he mentored and encountered will emulate his behavior. Then his passing will not have been in vain. Hope I will encounter many more Dr. Price's in the future. Not only in the surgeons but nurses, therapists, receptionists, administrators, pca's....

Many blessings to you Dr. Price. You will be sorely missed.

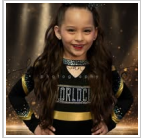
