After a long battle with schizophrenia and trying to navigate a failed healthcare system, Quinlan (Quin) A. Bell, 21, of Columbus, Ohio, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, November 1, 2022. Quin was born on April 17, 2001, in Columbus, Ohio, the son of John Bell and Rosa (Garcia) Burnam. He graduated from Whetstone High School in 2018 with straight As, and a member of the football team. He had a dream of joining the military and studying business. Prior to his 4-year illness, Quin was working for EMI Landscape Management and a family contracting business. God granted him with so many beautiful talents; he was a writer and musician. Leading up to his passing, he was writing his own music lyrics and loved rap music. He was also an amazing drummer, and he would hold several “jam sessions” with his older brother, Sean Bell. Quin also enjoyed nature, walking, and weightlifting. But one thing about Quin that made him so special was his gentle soul. He was a gentle giant with a huge heart, and he loved his family. He will be missed by so many people that loved him, but we are comforted in knowing he is reunited with family in heaven, especially his sweet mother, Rosa. Quin is survived by his father John, (stepfather) Ben Burnam Sean (brother), and Johnny (half-brother). He is also survived by his maternal grandmother, Margret Bell and several aunts, uncles, and cousins. Preceded in death by his mother, Rosa (Garcia) Burnam who tragically passed away in 2021; paternal

and maternal grandparents; and other loving members of the Garcia, Mandriotti, and Bell families.
