Ralph Poulson, age 87, of Powell, Ohio passed away on July 9, 2022, at Kobacker House in Columbus following an extended illness.

Ralph was born in Cleveland and raised in Ashtabula. He attended The Ohio State University, where he met his wife, Beverly. Ralph spent most of his career as an aircraft engineer at Rockwell International in Columbus. He also designed aircraft for Snow Aviation.

Ralph was a loving husband and father of three children. He and Beverly enjoyed traveling the world with friends and family. Ralph served as an usher at Worthington Presbyterian Church for many years and was an active member of his HOA. He could fix anything and was generous with his time and talent to help friends and neighbors in need. Ralph made significant contributions to the genealogy of his family and its branches. After believing he was of Norwegian descent for decades, Ralph recently discovered he was a Forest Finn.

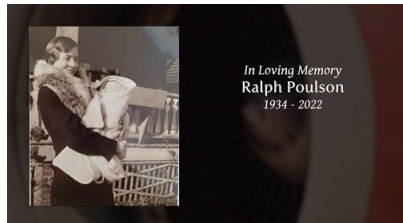
