Ralph L. Windsor, age 91, passed away September 20, 2012. He was born in Marengo, OH, July 4, 1921. A Veteran of World War II, he served in the 9th Air Force in England, France and Belgium until his discharge on November 2, 1945. He attended Ohio Wesleyan University. After 36 years of service, Mr. Windsor retired from the Accounting Department of the Clark Grave Vault Company. Ralph was known for his lifelong love of birding, and his tremendous dedication to saving the endangered Eastern Blue Bird. He made hundreds of blue bird boxes and feeders in his retirement years that were installed around Dublin and the surrounding area. He was a man who took pleasure in the simple things in life often saying, "Just like downtown!" to describe his happy outlook. He was preceded in death by the love of his life, Bonnie Jeanne Gaddis Windsor who passed away in 1999 after 53 years of marriage. Also preceding him in death were his parents, Alvin and Myrta Windsor; sister, Pearl Westbrook; son-in-law, David Prebenda, and sister, Erma Robson. He is survived by daughters, Bonnie (Jeff) Gahr, Chicago; Carol Smith, Columbus; Vicki (Brian) Moran, Dublin, and Sandy (John) O'Shaughnessy, Plymouth, MI.
