She was on the Huron Library Board, Firelands Symphony Orchestra Board, Cancer

Becky found great joy in serving others and in 2000 was recognized by The Women's Center of Providence Hospital as a Woman of Excellence for her service to the Sandusky area community. Becky was very much a people person and enjoyed hosting parties, going out for dinner and just being with groups of people. Becky loved her sons and their families but the progression of Alzheimer's made it difficult for her to spend as much time with them.
