Richard A. Coleman, age 90, formerly of Powell, OH and Findlay, OH died Saturday, June 1, 2013 at Wexner Heritage House in Columbus, OH. He was the retired Director of Manufacturing Engineering with Whirlpool Corporation in Findlay, OH. A graduate of Newtown High School, Newtown, Indiana, Dick was a 1948 graduate of Purdue University. He was a 1st Lt. in the United States Army during WWII and was awarded the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star Medal. He was a former member of the First Presbyterian Church of Findlay and the Findlay Kiwanis Club and was currently a member of New Hope Church in Powell.
