Richard "Brent" Derry, 55, lost his short and courageous battle with cancer on June 30, 2021 in Marion, Ohio.

Brent was a loving son and best friend to his parents, Rick and Marlene (Wiles) Derry of Marion, Ohio, formerly of Columbus, Ohio. He was born December 20, 1965 in Zanesville, OH and besides a short residence in Texas, lived his entire life in the Columbus and Delaware, Ohio areas.
